HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 26

1 A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING AND COMMENDING THE MEMBERS OF THE
2 GERMANTOWN HIGH SCHOOL BAND UNDER THE LEADERSHIP OF BAND DIRECTOR
3 JUSTIN HARVISON FOR WINNING THE 7A 2024 STATE MARCHING BAND
4 CHAMPIONSHIP AND FOR THEIR OTHER OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS.

5 WHEREAS, the Germantown High School Band reigned supreme to
6 be named state champions after winning the 7A 2024 State Marching
7 Band Championship held at Northwest Rankin High School in Brandon,
8 Mississippi; and

9 WHEREAS, under the leadership of band director Justin
10 Harvison, this championship is the fourth state championship for
11 the band and the second in three years, as they won the state
12 title during the 2022 marching season when the school competed in
13 6A; they were the 7A State Runner-Up in 2023; and they took
14 first-place in the 5A State Championship in 2013 and 2017; and

15 WHEREAS, in addition to being named 7A 2024 State Marching
16 Band Champions, the band members also took home first place in
17 Colorguard, General Effect, Music Performance and Visual
18 Performance, as well as third place in Percussion; and



19 WHEREAS, throughout their season of competition, the band
20 received a number of awards, as they were named grand champions at
21 the Conquistador Classic at Olive Branch High School; they were a
22 finalist and took fourth place overall in the Bands of America
23 Memphis Regional, as well as Outstanding Visual Performance and
24 third place in Class 2A; and in addition to scoring All Superior
25 ratings at state evaluations, they also claimed the Governor's Cup
26 at the Pearl Invitational and also finished the Bands of America
27 St. Louis Super Regional in the top 15 of 70 total bands; and

28 WHEREAS, the band's 2024 field program, "Wild Card", was nine
29 minutes long and featured the music of Henry Purcell, Frank
30 Ticheli, Jules Massenet and Billie Eilish, giving the crowd a
31 variety of music from the Baroque to songs that have been on the
32 radio in the last year; and

33 WHEREAS, the show was a crowd favorite at the various
34 competitions, and in addition to the musical variety, the show
35 also included some "unexpected" set pieces like slides that were
36 incorporated into the performance; and

37 WHEREAS, the Germantown High School marching season is a long
38 process that begins with tryouts in April and continues into the
39 fall, and the 166 talented band members include the following:
