SENATE BILL NO. 2151

AN ACT TO REQUIRE PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICTS, PUBLIC CHARTER 2 SCHOOLS AND CERTAIN STATE HIGH SCHOOLS TO DEVELOP AND ADOPT 3 POLICIES TO BAN THE POSSESSION OR RESTRICT THE USE OF CELL PHONES BY STUDENTS DURING CLASS OR WHILE UNDER THE SUPERVISION AND 5 CONTROL OF AN EMPLOYEE OR EMPLOYEES OF THE SCHOOL; TO PROVIDE FOR 6 POTENTIAL EXCEPTIONS WHICH ALLOW STUDENTS TO POSSESS OR USE CELL 7 PHONES UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. (1) A public school district, public charter 10 school, agricultural high school, the Mississippi Schools for the 11 Deaf and the Blind, the Mississippi School of the Arts and the Mississippi School for Mathematics and Science shall develop and 12 13 adopt specific policies to ban the possession or restrict the use 14 of cell phones by students during class or while under the supervision and control of an employee or employees of the school. 15 16 In developing and adopting a policy under this section, 17 a school may include exceptions to allow a student to possess or 18 use a cell phone under any of the following circumstances: 19 In the case of an emergency, or in response to a 20 perceived threat of danger;
