1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-41-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REVISE THE DEFINITION OF THE TERM "PUBLIC BODY"; TO INCLUDE RURAL 3 WATER ASSOCIATIONS UNDER THE OPEN MEETINGS ACT; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 25-41-3, Mississippi Code of 1972, 6 7 is amended as follows: 25-41-3. For purposes of this chapter, the following words 8 9 shall have the meaning ascribed herein, to wit: 10 "Public body" means any executive or administrative (a) board, commission, authority, council, department, agency, bureau 11 12 or any other policymaking entity, or committee thereof, of the State of Mississippi, or any political subdivision or municipal 13 14 corporation of the state, whether the entity be created by statute or executive order, which is supported wholly or in part by public 15 funds or expends public funds, and any standing, interim or 16 17 special committee of the Mississippi Legislature as well as any rural water association, rural water system or any nonprofit, 18
