## SENATE BILL NO. 2319

AN ACT TO ENACT THE CONTRACEPTION BEGINS AT ERECTION ACT; TO 1 2 DEFINE TERMS; TO PROVIDE THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR A PERSON TO 3 DISCHARGE GENETIC MATERIAL WITHOUT THE INTENT TO FERTILIZE AN 4 EMBRYO; TO PROVIDE FOR CRIMINAL PENALTIES; TO PROVIDE CERTAIN 5 EXCEPTIONS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. (1) This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Contraception Begins at Erection Act." 8 9 (2) It shall be unlawful for a person to discharge genetic 10 material without the intent to fertilize an embryo. 11 (3) Upon conviction of a violation of this section, a person shall be fined: 12 13 (a) One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) for a first offense; 14 15 (b) Five Thousand Dollars (\$5000.00) for a second offense; and 16 17 (c) Ten Thousand Dollars (10,000.00) for a third or 18 subsequent offense.

19 (4) This section shall not apply to the discharge of genetic20 material:

(a) Donated or sold to a facility for the purpose of
future procedures to fertilize an embryo; and

(b) Discharged with the use of a contraceptive or
 contraceptive method intended to prevent fertilization of an
 embryo.

26 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from 27 and after July 1, 2025.
