- AN ACT TO REQUIRE IMMEDIATE NOTIFICATION OF AN ESCAPE BE GIVEN TO THE MISSISSIPPI BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION AND LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 **SECTION 1.** (1) The Mississippi Bureau of Investigation and
- 6 local law enforcement shall be immediately notified of an inmate
- 7 or detainee escape as soon as that escape is known.
- 8 (2) (a) If the escape occurs at a local jail or regional
- 9 prison, the sheriff shall make the notification required under
- 10 this section.
- 11 (b) If the escape occurs at a state prison facility,
- 12 the Mississippi Department of Corrections shall make the
- 13 notification required under this section.
- 14 (3) For the purposes of this section, "local law
- 15 enforcement" means the sheriff and police chiefs of the county
- 16 where the escape occurred and the sheriff and police chiefs of the
- 17 county where the original crime occurred.

18 **SECTION 2.** This act shall take effect and be in force from

19 and after July 1, 2025.
