SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 515

- A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION APPLYING FOR A UNITED STATES
 CONSTITUTION ARTICLE V AMENDMENTS CONVENTION SPECIFICALLY RELATING
 TO CONGRESSIONAL TERM LIMITS.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 WHEREAS, Article V of the Constitution of the United States
- 6 provides authority for a Convention to be called by the Congress
- 7 of the United States for the purpose of proposing Amendments to
- 8 the Constitution upon application of two-thirds of the
- 9 legislatures of the separate states ("Madison Amendments
- 10 Convention"); and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Mississippi favors
- 12 the proposal and ratification of an Amendment to said Constitution
- 13 which shall provide Congressional Term Limits; NOW, THEREFORE,
- 14 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI, THE
- 15 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN:
- 16 **SECTION 1.** That, as provided for in Article V of the
- 17 Constitution of the United States, the Legislature of the State of
- 18 Mississippi herewith respectfully applies for an Amendments

- 19 Convention to be called for the purpose of proposing an Amendment
- 20 to the Constitution of the United States of America to set a limit
- 21 on the number of terms that a person may be elected as a Member of
- 22 the United States House of Representatives and to set a limit on
- 23 the number of terms that a person may be elected as a Member of
- 24 the United States Senate.
- 25 **SECTION 2.** This application shall be considered as covering
- 26 the same subject matter as the applications from other States to
- 27 Congress to call an Amendments Convention to set a limit on the
- 28 number of terms that a person may be elected to the House of
- 29 Representatives of the Congress of the United States and the
- 30 Senate of the United States; and this application shall be
- 31 aggregated with the same for the purpose of attaining the
- 32 two-thirds of states necessary to require Congress to call a
- 33 limited convention on this subject, but shall not be aggregated
- 34 with any other applications on any other subject.
- 35 **SECTION 3.** This application constitutes a continuing
- 36 application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of
- 37 the United States of America until the legislatures of at least
- 38 two-thirds of the several states have made applications on the
- 39 same subject.
- 40 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That a certified copy of this
- 41 application be transmitted by the Secretary of State, to the
- 42 President of the United States Senate, to the Speaker of the
- 43 United States House of Representatives, to each member of the

- 44 applicant's delegation to the United States Congress, and to the
- 45 presiding officers of each house of the several state
- 46 legislatures, requesting their cooperation in applying for the
- 47 Amendments Convention limited to the subject matter contemplated
- 48 by this application.
