## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 531

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE CREATION OF THE  
2 MISSISSIPPI-ISRAEL JOINT LEGISLATIVE CAUCUS.

3 WHEREAS, it is with great pride that we celebrate and  
4 recognize the creation of the Mississippi-Israel Joint Legislative  
5 Caucus with the aim of fostering and strengthening the  
6 long-standing relationship and history that exists between the  
7 United States of America and Israel to the mutual benefit of both  
8 countries with leadership in all of the states; and

9 WHEREAS, the caucus will reinforce the strong bilateral ties  
10 and shared values between the State of Mississippi and Israel. It  
11 will also foster mutual understanding and collaborative  
12 initiatives between the two governments; and

13 WHEREAS, the specific goals of strengthening political,  
14 economic, and cultural bonds will be of mutual benefit to both  
15 regions, resulting in advancing trade relations, facilitating  
16 educational exchanges, and promoting cultural understanding to  
17 maintain and strengthen the overall relationship between  
18 Mississippi and Israel; and



19           WHEREAS, the shared goals of the caucus will introduce  
20 opportunities for exchange and understanding between the two  
21 governments and their respective people:

22           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF  
23 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That  
24 the creation of the Mississippi-Israel Joint Legislative Caucus is  
25 recognized, and the goals and purpose of the caucus are celebrated  
26 for the long-term impact that will benefit both the State of  
27 Mississippi and Israel.

28           BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate is  
29 hereby authorized and directed to transmit a certified copy of  
30 this resolution to the National Co-Chairs of the American-Israel  
31 Legislative Caucus, forwarded to the Mississippi congressional  
32 delegation and be made available to the Capitol Press Corps.
