SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 93

1 A RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE COMMENDATION AND THANKS OF THE 2 MISSISSIPPI SENATE TO DESOTO COUNTY DEPUTY SHERIFF BRIAN BROCK OF 3 SOUTHAVEN, MISSISSIPPI, FOR HIS SPLIT-SECOND DECISION TO PULL INTO THE PATH OF AN ONCOMING VEHICLE DRIVING AT A HIGH RATE OF SPEED IN 4 5 THE WRONG DIRECTION ON INTERSTATE 269 TO PREVENT A COLLISION WITH OTHER MOTORISTS.

- 7 WHEREAS, a DeSoto County Deputy Sheriff was hospitalized on
- 8 March 4, 2025, after being intentionally struck by a wrong-way
- driver on Interstate 269. Authorities have identified the DeSoto 9
- 10 County Deputy Sheriff as 35-year-old Brian Brock of Southaven,
- 11 Mississippi; and
- WHEREAS, Deputy Brock, knowing the car was coming his way, 12
- 13 positioned himself on the shoulder of the road in the path of the
- 14 oncoming vehicle. When he saw the lights approaching from the
- 15 wrong direction, Deputy Brock said, "I made a choice that very
- certainly could have been my last. I tugged on my seatbelt twice 16
- and said, This is it for me, but I'm going to do it." Then Deputy 17
- 18 Brock drove his vehicle into the path of the oncoming car. He
- took the impact head on, and he saved the man behind him, who was 19
- 20 a doctor who said, "That Deputy was an angel. My life flashed in

- 21 front of me, and I closed my eyes. When I opened them, I saw that
- 22 deputy car"; and
- 23 WHEREAS, Deputy Brock has been labeled a hero. "The hardest
- 24 choices require the strongest will, and that's exactly what our
- 25 Deputy did last night," DeSoto County Sheriff Thomas Tuggle said;
- 26 and
- 27 WHEREAS, we can never repay Officer Brock and other first
- 28 responders for their action in the line of duty. We should not
- 29 pause and remember to thank police officers and first responders
- 30 only in the wake of possible tragedy, we should do it every day:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 32 MISSISSIPPI, That we do hereby extend the commendation and thanks
- 33 of the Mississippi Senate to DeSoto County Deputy Sheriff Brian
- 34 Brock of Southaven, Mississippi, for his split-second decision to
- 35 pull into the path of an oncoming vehicle driving at a high rate
- 36 of speed in the wrong direction on Interstate 269 to prevent a
- 37 collision with other motorists.
- 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this resolution be presented to
- 39 DeSoto County Deputy Sheriff Brian Brock, forwarded to DeSoto
- 40 County Sheriff Thomas Tuggle, and made available to the Capitol
- 41 Press Corps.
