REPORT OF CONFERENCE COMMITTEE

We, the undersigned conferees, have had under consideration the amendments to the following entitled BILL:

H. B. No. 1131: 2024 Local Improvements Project Fund; clarify and correct names and purposes of certain.

We, therefore, respectfully submit the following report and recommendation:

1. That the Senate recede from its Amendment No. 1.

2. That the House and Senate adopt the following amendment:

Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

11 SECTION 1. Section 5, Chapter 534, Laws of 2024, is amended 12 as follows:

Monies transferred pursuant to Section 1 of 13 Section 5. (1)14 this act into the 2022 IHL Capital Improvements Fund created in 15 Section 37-101-83, Mississippi Code of 1972, shall be disbursed by 16 the Department of Finance and Administration, pursuant to the authority to spend those monies granted by an appropriation bill 17 18 passed separately during the 2024 Regular Session, with the 19 approval of the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher 20 Learning on those projects related to the universities under its 21 management and control to pay the costs of capital improvements, renovation and/or repair of existing facilities, furnishings 22 23 and/or equipping facilities for public facilities as hereinafter 24 described:
