COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO 1 PROPOSED TO**

House Bill No. 1128

BY: Committee

**Amend by striking all after the enacting clause and inserting
in lieu thereof the following:**

22 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-113-55, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
23 amended as follows:
24 37-113-55. There is created in the State Treasury a special
25 fund to be designated as the "Mississippi State University
26 Veterinary School Fund." The fund shall be maintained by the
27 State Treasurer as a separate and special fund, separate and apart
28 from the General Fund of the state. Monies in the fund shall be
29 disbursed by the * * * Board of Trustees of State Institutions of
30 Higher Learning to assist Mississippi State University with paying
31 costs associated with the design, construction, renovation,



32 repairs, and equipping of the Wise Center. Unexpended amounts
33 remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall not lapse
34 into the State General Fund, and any interest earned or investment
35 earnings on amounts in the fund shall be deposited into such fund.

36 **SECTION 2.** Section 1 of Chapter 534, Laws of 2024, is amended
37 as follows:

38 Section 1. Upon the effective date of this act, the State
39 Treasurer, in conjunction with the State Fiscal Officer, shall
40 transfer the amounts listed below from the Capital Expense Fund
41 (Fund No. 6499C00000) to each of the following named funds:

77 **SECTION 3.** Section 29-9-9, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
78 brought forward as follows:

79 29-9-9. (1) Whenever any vehicle, equipment, office
80 furniture, office fixture or any other personal property which has
81 been acquired or is owned by any institution, department or agency



82 of the State of Mississippi becomes obsolete or is no longer
83 needed or required for the use of such institution, department or
84 agency, the same may be: (a) sold for cash, transferred, traded
85 or exchanged for other property, furniture, equipment, fixture or
86 vehicle needed by said institution, department or agency after
87 having first obtained the written approval of the Governor's
88 Office of General Services and the State Auditor or approval by
89 the Legislative Budget Office if utilized under the jurisdiction
90 of the Legislature; or (b) donated to any institution, department
91 or agency of the State of Mississippi, or any political
92 subdivision or local governing authority of the state. The
93 singular shall include the plural. Transfers, trades, exchanges
94 or donations made pursuant to this subsection may be made to any
95 political subdivision or local governing authority of the State of
96 Mississippi.

97 (2) The proceeds of all cash sales made, as authorized in
98 this section, shall be paid over into the support and maintenance
99 or contingent fund of the institution, department or agency as it
100 deems best.

101 (3) The head of each state institution, department or agency
102 shall be responsible and liable personally and on his official
103 bond, in the amount of the value shown on the state inventory, for
104 the disposal of any property contrary to the provisions of this
105 section.



106 (4) The Office of General Services, on the approval of the
107 Public Procurement Review Board, is hereby authorized and
108 empowered to make reasonable rules and regulations and to require
109 such information as may be necessary to carry out the purpose and
110 provisions of this section.

111 (5) Any violation of the provisions hereof by any elected
112 head of any institution, department, commission or agency of the
113 State of Mississippi, or any appointee or employee of any
114 institution, department, agency or commission coming under the
115 provisions of this section, shall constitute a misdemeanor and,
116 upon conviction therefor, shall be punished by a fine of not
117 exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) in addition to personal
118 and official liability, as hereinabove provided.

119 (6) The disposal of any unneeded personal property at the
120 project described in Section 57-75-5(f)(vi), may be made in
121 accordance with the provisions of the Mississippi Major Economic
122 Impact Act by the Mississippi Major Economic Impact Authority,
123 under such rules and regulations as may be adopted by such
124 authority.

125 (7) The disposal of any alternative housing units purchased
126 through the Mississippi Alternative Housing Pilot Program may be
127 made by the Mississippi Emergency Management Agency as required by
128 federal law to be in compliance with regulations of the federal
129 articles of agreement and its awarded conditions, and upon
130 approval of the Public Procurement Review Board.



131 (8) This section shall not be applicable to the State
132 Veterans Homes in the event the State Veterans Affairs Board has
133 contracted for property management services at the State Veterans
134 Homes.

135 **SECTION 4.** (1) Upon the effective date of this act, the
136 State Treasurer, in conjunction with the State Fiscal Officer,
137 shall transfer the sum of Two Million Forty-seven Thousand Four
138 Hundred Twenty-five Dollars and Seventy-seven Cents
139 (\$2,047,425.77) from the Capital Expense Funds- DFA (Fund No.
140 6494300000) to the 2022 IHL Capital Improvements Fund (Fund No.
141 6611330000) created in Section 37-101-83, Mississippi Code of
142 1972.

143 (2) These funds shall be disbursed by the Department of
144 Finance and Administration to the University of Southern
145 Mississippi, with the approval of the Board of Trustees of State
146 Institutions of Higher Learning on those projects related to the
147 universities under its management and control, to pay the costs
148 for the repair or renovation of systems or buildings on the
149 Hattiesburg campus.

150 **SECTION 5.** On the effective date of this act, the State
151 Treasurer, in conjunction with the State Fiscal Officer, shall
152 transfer the sum of Sixteen Million Dollars (\$16,000,000.00) from
153 the Capital Expense Fund (Fund No. 6449C00000) to each of the
154 following named funds:

161 **SECTION 6.** During the period beginning July 1, 2024, through
162 June 30, 2025, the University of Mississippi Medical Center shall
163 transfer Four Million Thirty Thousand Four Hundred Sixteen Dollars
164 (\$4,030,416.00) for the Office of Mississippi Physician Workforce
165 to the Mississippi State Department of Health for the transfer of
166 the program that occurred in House Bill No. 1129, 2024 Regular
167 Session.

168 **SECTION 7.** Section 43 of Chapter 95, Laws of 2024, is
169 amended as follows:

170 Section 43. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1(a) of
171 this act, One Million Four Hundred Thousand Dollars
172 (\$1,400,000.00) is provided for the continuation of * * * the
173 current school * * * safety platform.

174 **SECTION 8.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
175 and after its passage.

**Further, amend by striking the title in its entirety and
inserting in lieu thereof the following:**

9 TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE CAPITAL EXPENSE FUND-DFA TO THE 2022
10 IHL CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND; TO DIRECT THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN
11 FUNDS FROM THE CAPITAL EXPENSE FUND TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE LAND
12 IMPROVEMENT FUND AND TO THE MISSISSIPPI VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTER
13 LENGTH-OF-SERVICE AWARDS PROGRAM FUND; TO DIRECT THE UNIVERSITY OF
14 MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER TO TRANSFER A CERTAIN SUM FOR THE
15 OFFICE OF MISSISSIPPI PHYSICIAN WORKFORCE TO THE MISSISSIPPI STATE
16 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH; TO AMEND SECTION 43 OF CHAPTER 95, LAWS OF
17 2024, TO REVISE THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 APPROPRIATION TO THE STATE
18 DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PROVIDE THAT A CERTAIN SUM MAY BE USED
19 FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE CURRENT SCHOOL SAFETY PLATFORM; AND
20 FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
